## 9. **Review policies for video submissions and region voting prior to the convention (Brooks)**

The videos will be shared with region advisors in order for each region to vote to select their state board nominees prior to the state convention.

## 10. **State Convention arrangements**

- Middle School Student Council Convention report from MS Executive Director – Heidi Devlin explained that the middle school convention will no longer be taking place. The SDHSAA will now allow students in grades 7-12 to attend the high school student council convention. Separate activities will be planned for students in grades 7 and 8. Attending advisors will be responsible for organizing those activities. During the region meetings, all 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will meet to select the middle school representative on the state board. There will be no DJ for the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade activities night this year.
