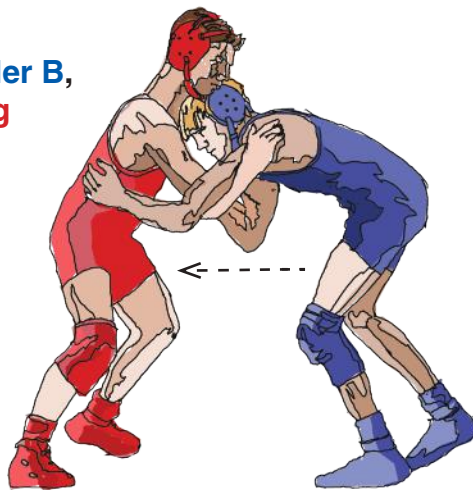
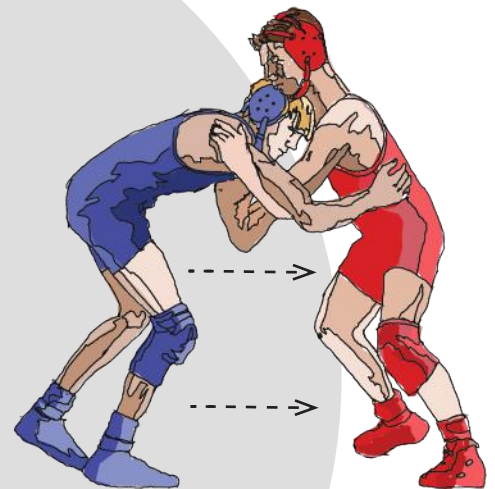
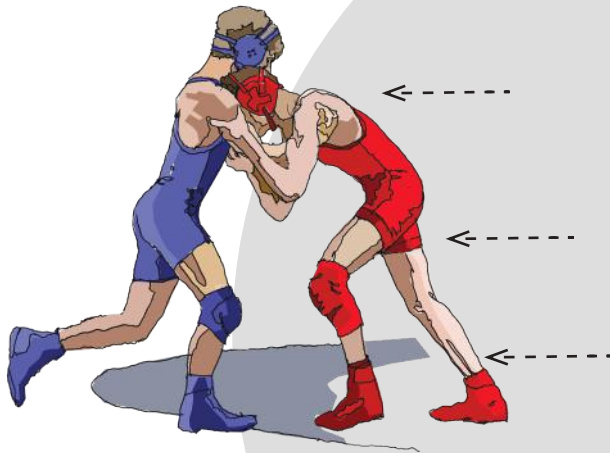


Rule 7-6-1 Each wrestler is required to make an honest attempt to stay within the center of the mat and wrestle aggressively, regardless of position or the time or score of match.

2. **Wrestler A** is prevented from getting back inbounds by **Wrestler B**, penalize **Wrestler B** for **Stalling Violation**.



2. **Wrestler A**, with forehead buried in **Wrestler B's** shoulder drives **Wrestler B** out of bounds. Penalize **Wrestler A** for **Stalling Violation**.

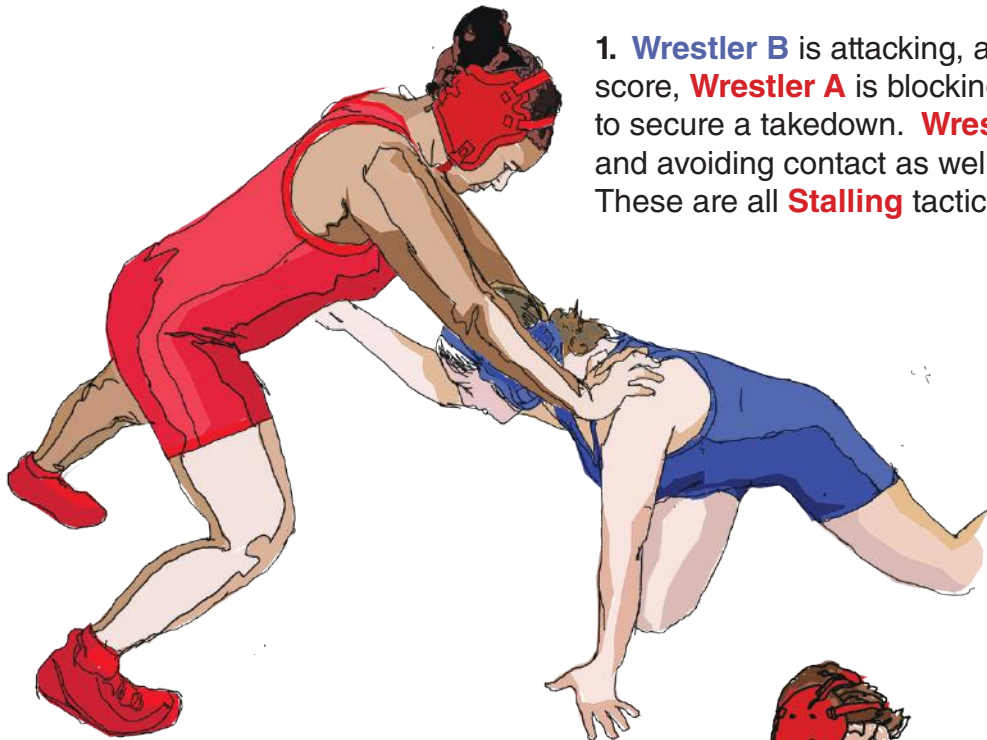


3. **Wrestler A**, pulls **Wrestler B** out of bounds. **Wrestler A** for **Stalling Violation** shall be called.

Rule 7-6-3 (a,b,c,d. & e)



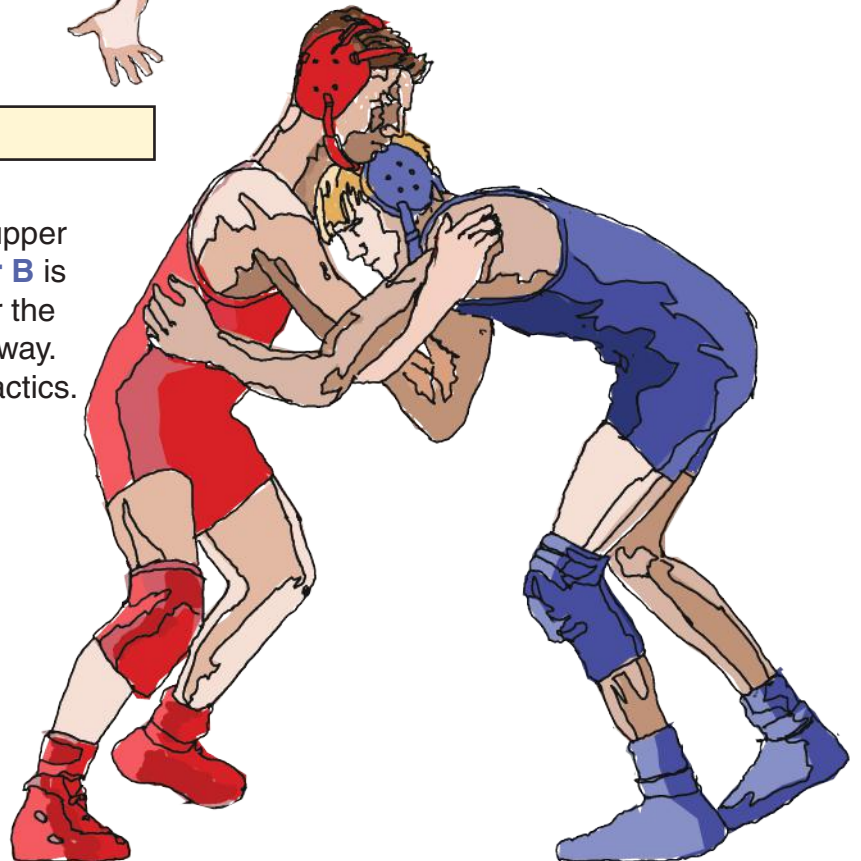
Rule 7-6-1 Each wrestler is required to make an honest attempt to stay within the center of the mat and wrestle aggressively, regardless of position or the time or score of match.



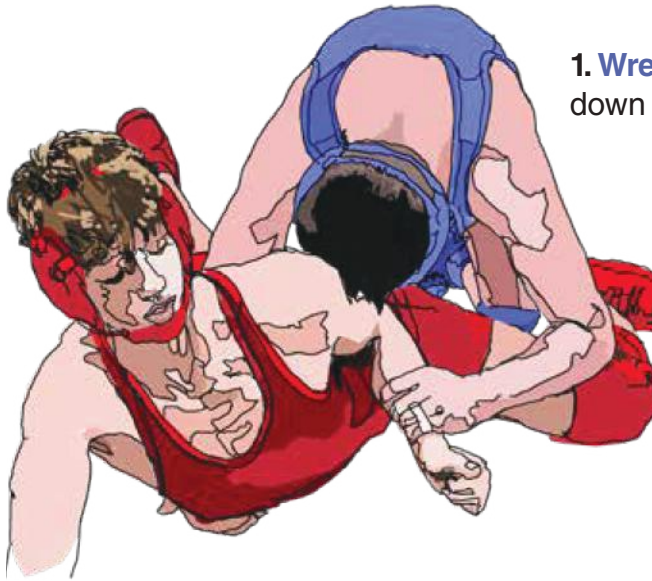
1. **Wrestler B** is attacking, attempting to score, **Wrestler A** is blocking with no counter to secure a takedown. **Wrestler A** is backing and avoiding contact as well as blocking. These are all **Stalling** tactics.

Rule 7-6-3 (a,b,c,d. & e)

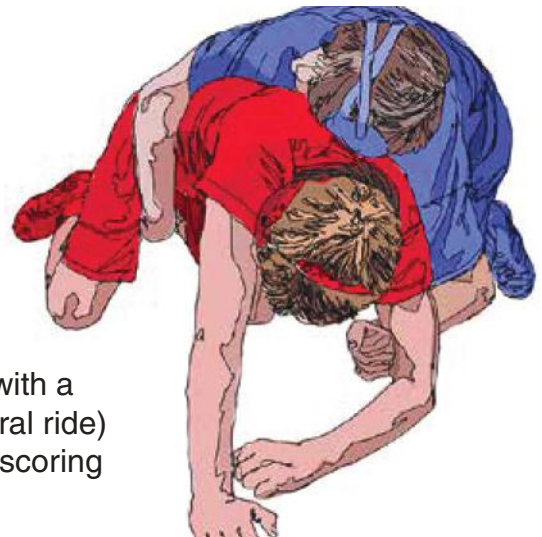
1. As **Wrestler A** works for upper body opportunities, **Wrestler B** is blocking with the head under the chin and pushing the body away. These are neutral **Stalling** tactics.



Rule 7-6-1 Each wrestler is required to make an honest attempt to stay within the center of the mat and wrestle aggressively, regardless of position or the time or score of the match. **Action** is to be maintained throughout the match by contestants wrestling aggressively whether on top, bottom or neutral position and both contestants are equally responsible for initiating action.

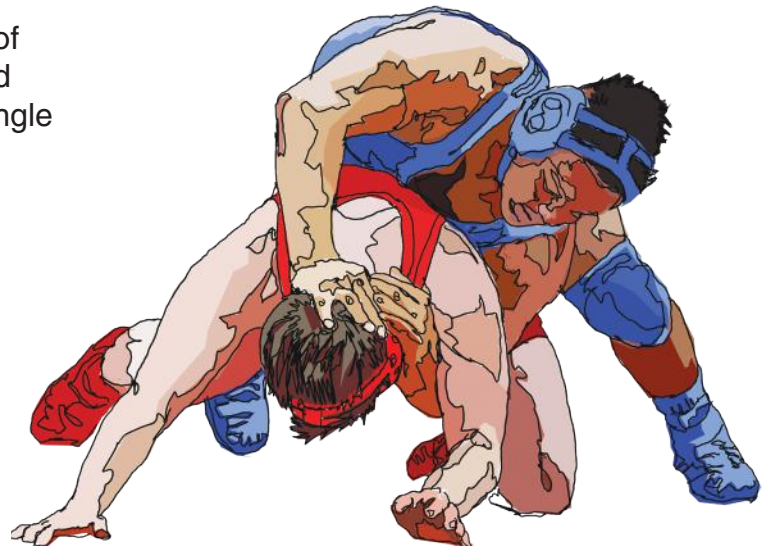


1. **Wrestler B** breaking **Wrestler A** down to hold without effort to score.



2. **Wrestler B** riding the hips with a thigh pry and under hook (spiral ride) blocking the **Wrestler A** from scoring is **Stalling**.

3. **Wrestler A** riding the hips of **Wrestler B** from the base and again no effort to create an angle to score near fall.

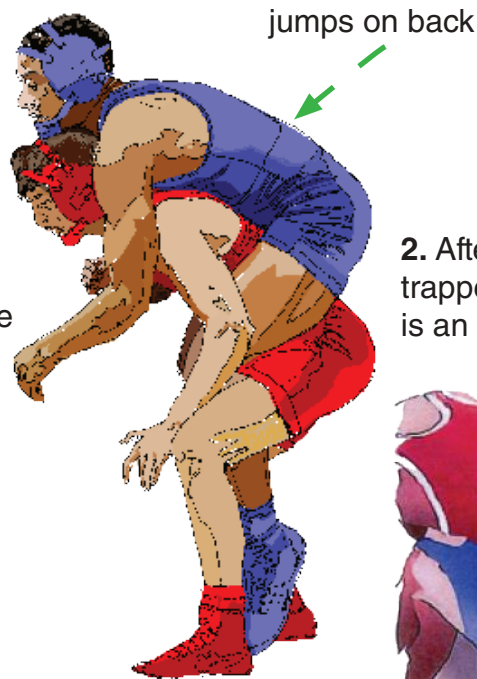


Rule 7-6-4

- a** Does not wrestle aggressively
- b** Holds heel to buttocks for 5 seconds
- c** Holds on to leg with two hands
- d** Stays behind opponent while on feet not

Rule 7-6-1 Each wrestler is required to make an honest attempt to stay within the center of the mat and wrestle aggressively, regardless of position or the time or score of the match. Action is to be maintained throughout the match by contestants wrestling aggressively whether on top, bottom or neutral position and both contestants are equally responsible for initiating action.

1. After **Wrestler A** stands, it is an offensive stalling violation on **Wrestler B** to jump up on the back of **Wrestler A** on bottom to draw a potentially dangerous call from the official. **Wrestler B** must make an attempt to return opponent, can't do it on opponents back.



2. After heel of **Wrestler B** is trapped to buttock for 5 seconds it is an **offensive stalling** call.



3 It is **offensive stalling** when the top wrestler locks on the leg for the purpose of preventing their scoring. In this illustration **Wrestler B** reaches over the back of **Wrestler A** to secure a spladle. That action from **Wrestler B** creates a twisting knee action which must be stopped. Either the stalling call is made which stops the knee twisting, or **Potentially Dangerous** call is made as it was caused by **Wrestler B**.
