

# From the President...

As President of the South Dakota Volleyball Officials Association, I'm proud to celebrate another successful season with our dedicated team of high school officials. Whether you're just starting out or have years of experience, your commitment to the sport makes a lasting impact on student-athletes across the state.

This year, I'd like to highlight three key areas that help us maintain excellence on the court: ball handling, legal uniforms, and good sportsmanship.

#### **Ball Handling: Staying Consistent**

Ball handling calls can be tough, especially in fast-paced rallies. A clean hit should be quick and controlled—no prolonged contact. Watch closely for double contacts when directed to a teammate vs. an opponent. While double contacts to a teammate are allowed, they are not allowed if intentionally or unintentionally directed to an opponent. These situations can certainly catch even the best officials off guard. Trust your judgment and make the call with confidence.

#### **Legal Uniforms: Keeping It Clear**

Uniform checks are more than routine—they help us keep the game organized and fair. All players should wear matching jerseys with visible numbers on the front and back. Libero jerseys must be clearly contrasting in color and design. Jewelry, specifically small studs above the chin are allowed. Confirm with the Coaches & Captains during the pre-match conference as well as doing a uniform check during warm-ups help to avoid delays and/or penalties.

#### **Good Sportsmanship: Leading by Example**

As officials, we help set the tone for respectful competition. When players show kindness, hustle, and teamwork, it makes the game better for everyone. Coaches and fans follow our lead—so let's model calm, clear communication and professionalism. A respectful explanation of a call can defuse tension and build trust.

Thank you for your dedication to high school volleyball. As SDVBOA President, I'm honored to work alongside such passionate and skilled officials. Let's keep learning, growing, and supporting each other as we serve the game we love.
