(Unsporting Conduct) Dismissed from meet:

_____, Head _____ Coach from _____ is disqualified from further competition for Unsporting Coaches Conduct, which includes behavior that is unethical or dishonorable. It includes, but is not limited to: disrespectfully addressing an official and any flagrant behavior. _____ is disqualified from further involvement in the meet and will be assessed a 1pt. team deduction. Reminder.... coaches are responsible for appropriate behavior and conduct.

(Unacceptable Conduct)

_____, Head _____ Coach from _____ has been assessed a 1pt. team deduction for Unacceptable Coaches Conduct, which includes behavior that is unethical or offensive. Reminder coaches are responsible for appropriate behavior and conduct.

(Coach on Infield) 1pt. team deduction.... on the infield without prior approval:

_____, Head _____ Coach from _____ has been assessed a 1pt. team deduction for entering the infield without prior approval. Reminder coaches cannot be on the infield at any time during the meet without prior approval.

- Per SDHSAA: ALL OFFICIALS and meet managers have the power to make this call with a written report to be made to the meet referee.

Note: Depending on the severity of the offense, Meet Referee will have PA announcer read one of the statements above:

- **UNSPORTING CONDUCT** – most severe - 1pt. deduction and removed from meet
- **UNACCEPTABLE CONDUCT** – level below unsporting – 1pt. deduction - coach may remain, however, coach is warned that if unethical or offensive behavior continues, unsporting conduct will be enforced
- **COACH ON INFIELD** – 1 pt. deduction - no other action required
